Primary Responsibilities: As a Health Scientist (Equity), this position will serve as a senior advisor on health and healthcare equity. Specifically, the position will:

- Provide guidance and strategic direction on policies, programmatic activities, partnerships, and innovative data and analytic approaches that support the integration of health equity across the Division's portfolio.
- Develop and implement frameworks to advance health equity science, action, and learning.
- Promote health equity science and data-driven intervention strategies.
- Facilitate the coordination of DHQP equity and disparities work and collaborate closely with leadership and subject matter experts at the Division and Center levels, across CDC, and with external partners.
- Engage regularly with the evaluation component of the unit to ensure a coordinated and robust assessment of DHQP's progress towards addressing inequities and disparities.
